

# **Creating Montessori Engagement Stations**

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Creating Montessori Engagement Stations provides a wide range of sensory engagement activities to your memory care residents to improve the quality of life. The Stations will offer activities for all levels of sensory, motor, cognitive and social abilities with the goal of reconnecting with pleasant memories and maintaining or improving skills needed in a person's daily life. The approach we use for our activities is the Montessori Method, that is all activities are designed to be self-correcting, choice based, and failure-free. The Engagement Stations activities will change either seasonally or themes to meet your residents needs and keep them engaged year-round.

The Montessori Engagement Stations is based on Montessori School, an environment with plenty of materials for hands-on learning, and residents are encouraged to focus on – and often stick with – activities that pique their interest. The Stations design are for residents that are mix in age with different interests, hobbies, and life-skills.

#### **Gardening Station**

Daily – spray plant with water and prune plants, sweep floor with broom.

Spring – Seeding and growing pants inside

- Build a box or bird house

- Flash-light repair
- Pipe fitting
- Tool matching on a pegboard
- Wooden cylinder blocks
- Screw or wrench & wood
- Loops, lace & wood
- Sorting screws by size
- Poker chips sorts

















Sports & Games Station (indoor/outdoor)

- Bowling
- Golfing and turf
- Beanbag toss
- Bocce ball toss
- Jenga

For example:

Mornings: 10 am – 11:30 am (you may vary a time)

Monday and Wednesday: Puzzles and Matching Engagement Stations

Tuesday and Thursday: Kitchen Activities and Workshop Engagement Stations

Friday: Office & Culture Work and Words & Letters Engagement Stations

Saturday and Sunday: Puzzles and Words & Letters Engagement Stations

Afternoons: 1:30-3:30pm (you may vary a time)

Monday, Wednesday, and Friday: Gardening Engagement Station (1:30-2:30 pm) and Creative Work Engagement Station (2:30-3:30pm)

Tuesday and Thursday: Office & Culture Work Engagement Station

Saturday and Sunday: Sports & Games and/or Creative Work Engagement Stations

Don't take everything out of the Engagement Station Container all at once; 4-6 items daily. Remember you have two containers in the morning and afternoon. Also, every two months swap out seasonal or holidays themes for your engagement stations – puzzles, words and letters, matchings, sports & games, etc.
